
Eligibility Reform

CMCS Goals Areas for Behavioral Health

- Increased use of screening to identify, ameliorate and/or treat mental and substance use disorder
- Increase access to behavioral health services for persons with serious and/or chronic disorders
- Same or better health outcomes as the general population for individuals with mental and substance use disorder.
- Properly implement the Affordable Care Act and MHPAEA.



CMCS Goals Areas for Behavioral Health

- Improving children's access to the right services at the right time
- Identifying a good benefit for children with behavioral health needs
- Improving positive life outcomes for the most vulnerable children
- Improving the quality of children's behavioral health services
- Consider, implement and bring to scale new practices if proven effective.


